It was passed in response to concerns that Native children were disproportionately removed from their homes and placed in non-Native homes. In this workshop we will identify how ICWA affects intervention, jurisdiction and placement. We will also discuss the importance of maintaining culture.

RPPS is a provision of the Strengthening Families Act that passed Congress 2014.
